



Design Division - best of the arrangement entries

ADULT FLOWER SHOW SCHEDULE - 2010

You are welcome to unleash your imagination. Please feel free to enter creative flower arrangements, and/or healthy looking potted plants! Follow the directions below to enter.

1. Your entry should weigh no more than 10 lbs, on our scale. For the plant division, except as noted, container diameter should not exceed 10".
2. Plants must have been grown by exhibitor for at least three months.
3. Common and botanical names must be written on entry cards. (entry clerks will assist with this.)
4. Entries must be clean and bug free.
5. Flower arrangements must be created by the exhibitor, however, the plant material used need not be grown by the exhibitor.
6. Accessories - small objects, which are not plant material, may be added to your design, if specified.
7. Artificial plant material is not permitted.
8. An exhibitor may enter as many different flower classes as desired, but may submit only one entry per class.
9. No entries will be accepted after 8:45am on Saturday April 17th, 2010.

Rules

ADULT DESIGN DIVISION

- CLASS 10: An arrangement suitable for a rectangular entry table (table dimensions 3'L x 15"D x 3'H set against a white wall. The color of the container should echo one of the colors in the arrangement.
- CLASS 11: Fresh branch arrangement - accessories permitted
A. Fresh branches/cut flowers may be added B. Evergreen branches
- CLASS 12: Miniature or small design - all fresh/all dried or a combination of both plant materials
A. No larger than 5" X 5" x 5" B. No larger than 8" X 8" x 8"
- CLASS 13: All fresh/all dried or a combination of both plant materials arranged in a container of your choice –accessories permitted
- CLASS 14: Invitational: Limited to 8 pre-assigned exhibitors. Create an arrangement suggesting Mardi Gras using 3 of the 4 provided items. The items are a piece of wire, one 4" roll of cardboard, a mask, and a pair of chopsticks. Items & registration may be obtained by calling 845-353-9019. Be creative! You may paint, twist, or decorate the items.

Judges' Criteria: *Scale of design, cultural perfection, color, design, creativity and expression, appropriateness, artistic concept.*

ADULT PLANT DIVISION

- CLASS 15: Plants grown by exhibitor from seeds, pits, bulbs or cuttings
Include a 3" x 5" card on how you started your plant
- CLASS 16: Houseplants
A. Plants grown primarily for their flowers 1" - 5" pot
B. Plants grown primarily for their flowers, 6" - 10" pot
C. Plants grown primarily for their foliage
D. African Violets E. Bonsai F. Orchids
- CLASS 17: Flowering branches not longer than 30" from cut end to tip. Natural (those blooming outdoors now) or Forced (those brought indoors and "forced" to bloom ahead of their outdoor bloom time)
A. Natural B. Forced
- CLASS 18: Hanging Basket - plants grown for flowers or foliage displayed in a hanging basket
(Pot may not exceed 12" in diameter)
A. Flowering B. Foliage
- CLASS 19: Succulents/Cacti
A. One specimen in a pot B. Three different specimens in a pot
C. Succulent/cacti dish garden (accessories permitted)



Judges' Criteria: *Correct botanical name, cultural perfection, symmetry, color, cleanliness, form.*

CHILDREN'S FLOWER SHOW SCHEDULE - 2010



Select a class in the Design Division and unleash your imagination and creativity, or pick one from the Plant Division and show off your green thumb, or do both. Enter as many different classes as you like, however, only one entry per class/subdivision is permitted. You may also take part in a classroom or a group project.

CHILDREN'S DESIGN DIVISION

- CLASS 1: Flower Arrangement
A. Pre K & K B. Grades 1 - 2 C. Grades 3 - 4 D. Grade 5 E. Grades 6 - 8
- CLASS 2: Terrariums or dish gardens - no larger than 15" x 21", weight not to exceed 10lbs
A. Pre K & K B. Grades 1 - 2 C. Grades 3 - 4 D. Grade 5 E. Grades 6 - 8
- CLASS 3: Creative display - no taller than 24" with a fairy tale, folk tale or fantasy theme
A. Pre K & K B. Grades 1 - 2 C. Grades 3 - 4 D. Grade 5 E. Grades 6 - 8
- CLASS 4: Miniature or small design - all fresh/all dried or a combination of both plant materials
A. No larger than 5" X 5" x 5" B. No larger than 8" X 8" x 8"
A. Pre K & K B. Grades 1 - 2 C. Grades 3 - 4 D. Grade 5 E. Grades 6 - 8

CHILDREN'S PLANT DIVISION

- CLASS 5: Plants grown by exhibitor from seeds, pits, bulbs, cuttings or forced branches
A. Pre K & K B. Grades 1 - 2 C. Grades 3 - 4 D. Grade 5 E. Grades 6 - 8
- CLASS 6: Houseplants/Cactus/Insect Eating Plants
(must have been owned and cared for a minimum of 2 months)
A. Pre K & K B. Grades 1 - 2 C. Grades 3 - 4 D. Grade 5 E. Grades 6 - 8
- CLASS 7: Flowering branches not longer than 30" from cut end to tip. Natural (those blooming outdoors now) or Forced (those brought indoors and "forced" to bloom ahead of their outdoor bloom time)
A. Natural B. Forced
A. Pre K & K B. Grades 1 - 2 C. Grades 3 - 4 D. Grade 5 E. Grades 6 - 8

CHILDREN'S CLASSROOM DIVISION

- CLASS 8: Any design or plant category submitted as a class project
(terrariums or dish gardens - no larger than 15" x 21", weight not to exceed 10 lbs)
A. Pre K & K B. Grades 1 - 2 C. Grades 3 - 4 D. Grade 5 E. Grades 6 - 8

CHILDREN'S GROUP DIVISION

- CLASS 9: Any design or plant category submitted as a group project
(terrariums or dish gardens - no larger than 15" x 21", weight not to exceed 10lbs)
A. Pre K & K B. Grades 1 - 2 C. Grades 3 - 4 D. Grade 5 E. Grades 6 - 8

FLOWER SHOW RULES

1. Individual designs may measure no more than an area of 15" x 21".
2. Your entry should weigh no more than 10 lbs. on our scale.
3. If you enter a design/arrangement category, you should create it yourself.
4. You may buy fresh flowers/plant materials to use in the design categories.
5. Accessories - small objects, which are not plant material, may be added to your design.
6. Any plants you bring to the show should be clean and bug-free.
7. No live animals and no electrical parts are permitted
8. No entries will be accepted after 8:45am on Saturday April 17th, 2010.
